A Protective Barrier

prevents extremist suicide attackers
from West Bank and Gaza from entering Israel



The Jordan River,

neither deep nor wide, forms a peaceful border
between the moderate states of Israel and Jordan

Since Israel and Jordan (Palestinian majority) signed a peace treaty in 1994, the border has been quiet. When moderate Palestinians from the West Bank and Gaza lead their neighbors to a true peace with Israel, the protective barrier will be redundant.
